

How to View Public Examination Results Remotely


Log in as normal to ePortal via <http://home.epsomcollege.org.uk>. You will need your ePortal credentials for this.

Over the summer vacation the results bitlet will be made available. It is shown below and is visible once logged in.

Click on the More button and a new page opens which deals solely with results of examinations.


There will be lots of examinations as the terminology covers every assessment as well as public examinations in a pupil's school career at Epsom.

Clicking on this will generate a pdf document which can be printed.

Important

ePortal is designed for routine use and is not designed for large numbers of connections. On GCE results day, i.e. for A level and AS level results, there may be up to 350 pupils trying to access their results. On GCSE results day, the number will be about 140 or so.

Please realise that some patience may be needed if large numbers access ePortal simultaneously.
